OTHER FREE ACTIVITIES ON THE SURF COAST

AROUND TORQUAY AND JAN JUC: **Cosy Corner** is an ideal family beach with sheltered swimming and shading trees. During big swells, **Bells Beach** and **Winkipop** offer spectacular waves for experienced surfers. **Visit the Sundial** on The Esplanade, near Deep Creek. **Kite and Windsurfing** is very popular on windy afternoons at **Point Danger**. Great to try and watch!

Take your time to travel the famous **Great Ocean Road** and discover some of the most spectacular scenery, waterfall walks and resort towns in Australia. **The Great Ocean Road Memorial Arch** at Eastern View, erected to commemorate the returned servicemen from World War 1 who built the Great Ocean Road between 1918 and 1932.

AROUND LORNE: Explore the beautiful **bush walks** around Lorne. Walk the rainforest gullies of the **Great Otway National Park**, which offers more than 50km of walking tracks around Lorne itself. Enjoy breathtaking views from **Teddy's Lookout**, offering one the best views of the Great Ocean Road. There is also a 1.6km circuit to three lookouts.

AROUND WINCHELSEA: **The Winchelsea Heritage Walk**, commencing at the Wincheslea Visitor Centre, features the Globe Theatre, Barwon Park Mansion, the Barwon River and heritage listed triple arched bridge - to name a few historic sites. Take a drive around the historic Majorie Lawrence Trail and explore the life of one the most adored dramatic sopranos of the 1900's.

AROUND ANGLESEA: **Anglesea River**, activities including canoeing, windsurfing, sailing or fishing. Relax on the sandy beaches. **Point Roadknight Beach** is popular with families. Visit one of several lookouts to view **Alcoa's open cut brown coal mine**, nestled in the valley behind Anglesea. Visit **Anglesea Heath** and view superb native flowers and rare orchids that bloom in the coastal heathlands during Spring.

AROUND AIREYS INLET: Enjoy a picnic at **Moggs Creek** picnic ground. Visit the **lighthouse**. The **walks** around Aireys Inlet range from short easy walks, such as those around the **lighthouse precinct** or nature walks at **Distillery Creek** and Moggs Creek Picnic areas, through to longer, strenuous walks such as the **Currawong Falls Circuit**.

Torquay Foreshore Playpark (GORCC)
Elephant Walk, The Esplanade, Torquay **3**



This multi-age playground is located on the foreshore of Torquay. This playground is well suited to a half day visit with picnic facilities, BBQ's, shady trees and a wide range of play structures to interest and challenge the kids .

Aireys Inlet Reserve Playground
Inlet Crescent, Aireys Inlet **20**



This playground is set in a picturesque location on Painkalac Creek, with views to the Split Point Lighthouse.

This reserve is ideal for a family picnic or BBQ and there are many other activities, with the adjacent Aireys Inlet skate park and lots of open space for a game of cricket, a kick of the footy or for kite flying.

Bark Hut Reserve Playground

Bob Pettitt Reserve Playground
Sunset Strip, Jan Juc **13**



This new multi age 'Coast to Creek' themed playground has a range of play features complemented by beautiful community artwork features and an evolving sensory garden.

There are many other reasons to visit this playground including a half court basketball/netball area, a soccer field, skate facilities, pathways, BBQ, shelter and picnic facilities.



26 Newling Reserve All Access Playground
Hendy Main Road, Moriac

This accessible multi-age playground has a rural theme, with many community art creations.

There are many activities for families to enjoy, with a large shelter, BBQ and picnic facilities, a skate park and a BMX track.

There is a sealed pathway meandering through the reserve which is a great place for kids to walk, ride or skate and they can admire the beautiful carved bollards along the way.



Riverbank Playground
Barwon Terrace, Winchelsea **28**



This delightful multi-age playground has a woolshed theme and is situated in a picturesque setting on the banks of the Barwon River.

The playground is complemented by picnic and BBQ facilities, pathways along the Barwon River and the adjacent Winchelsea Swimming Pool, which is a great place to visit to cool off in the summer.

17 Bellbrae Reserve Playground
School Road, Bellbrae

This playground has a 'Bellbrae Fauna' theme with lovely hand painted artwork by the Bellbrae Primary School students.

It is set in a fantastic location with BBQ and picnic facilities, nature trail, wetland area, oval and tennis courts.



18 Coogoorah Park Playground
River Reserve Road, Anglesea



This multi-age playground has an 'Inverloch' shipwreck theme, complete with a treasure map, a hidden treasure, a crow's nest, shark fins and a variety of great play items attached to shipwreck.

A visit to this playground can be a great day out with lots to do, including having a picnic or BBQ, using the nature trails and family bike trails, going fishing or launching a canoe.



31 Dean Marsh Playground
Pennyroyal Valley Road, Deans Marsh

The 'rustic' theme of this multi-age playground captures this rural town's appreciation of nature and culture.

A great place for a family picnic or BBQ with adjacent skate park, BMX track, oval and tennis courts.
